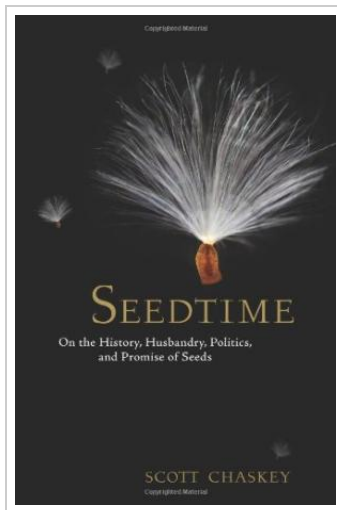




Seedtime: On the History, Husbandry, Politics and Promise of Seeds
