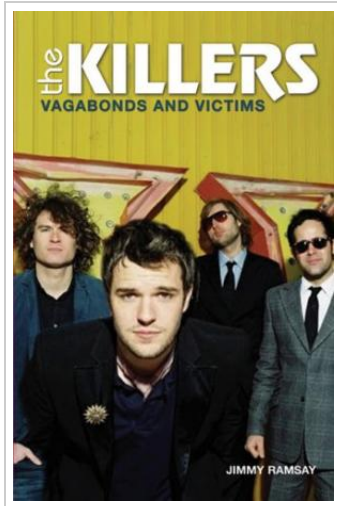




The Killers": Vagabonds and Victims
