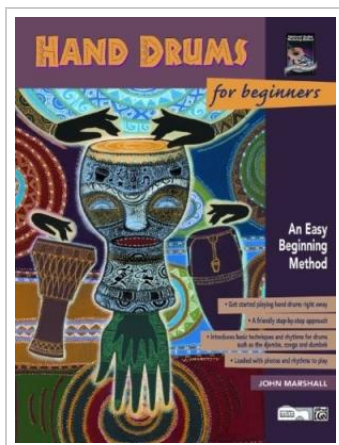




Hand Drums for Beginners
