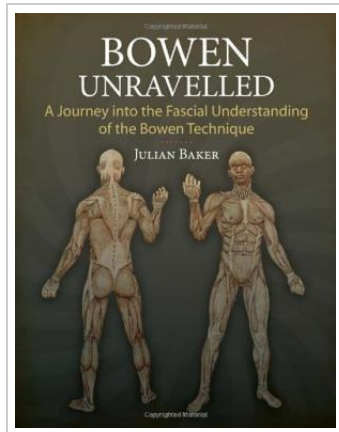




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Bowen Unravalled: A Journey Into the Fascial Understanding of the Bowen Technique
