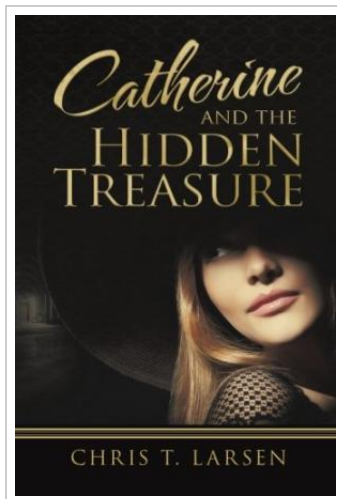




Catherine and the Hidden Treasure (Paperback)
