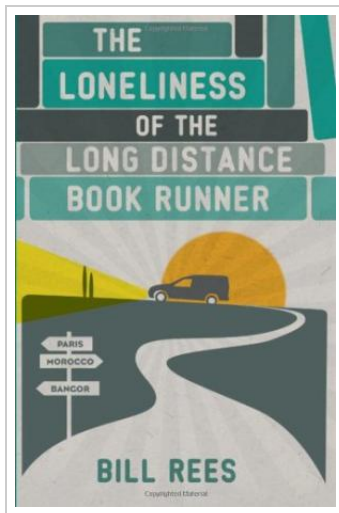




The Loneliness of the Long Distance Book Runner (Paperback)
