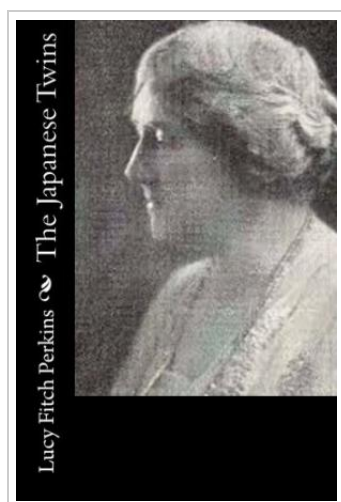




The Japanese Twins
