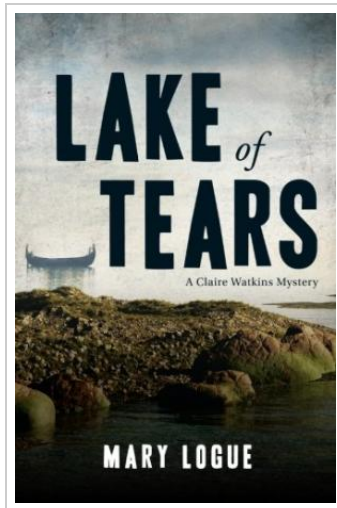




Lake of Tears
