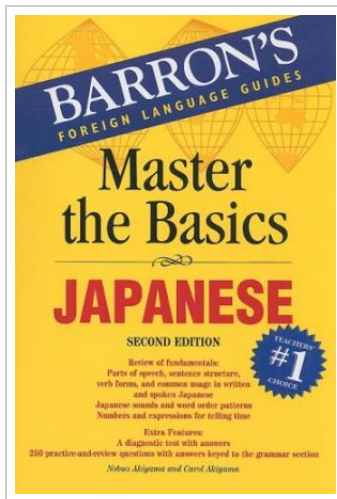




Master the Basics: Japanese
