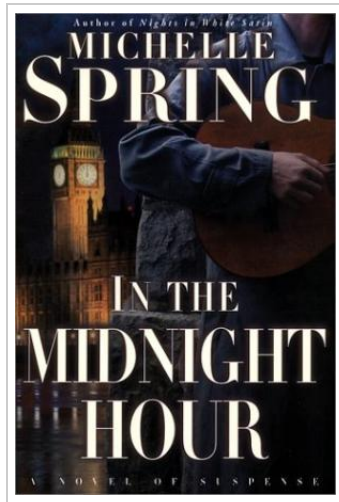




In the Midnight Hour
