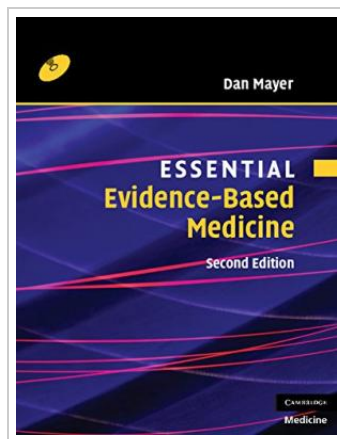




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Essential Evidence-based Medicine with CD-ROM (Mixed media product)

A CD-ROM accompanies the book to enable students to test their learning through a series of questions, with answers provided. This is an ideal introductory text for medical students, health sciences students and a wide range of other healthcare professionals.
