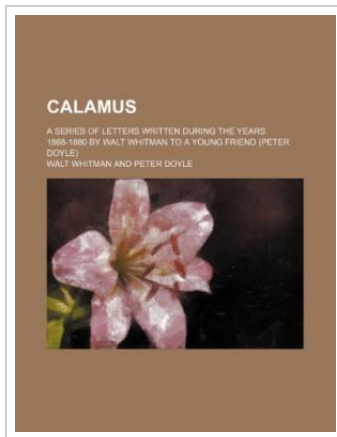




Calamus A Series of Letters Written During the Years 1868-1880 by Walt Whitman to a Young Friend Peter Doyle
