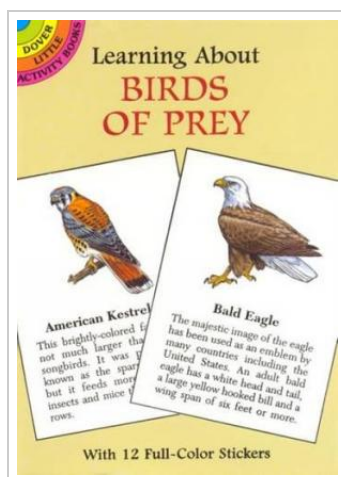




Learning About Birds of Prey
