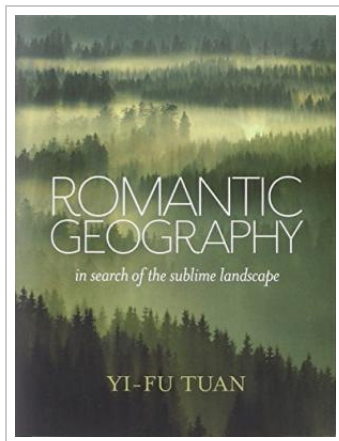




Romantic Geography
