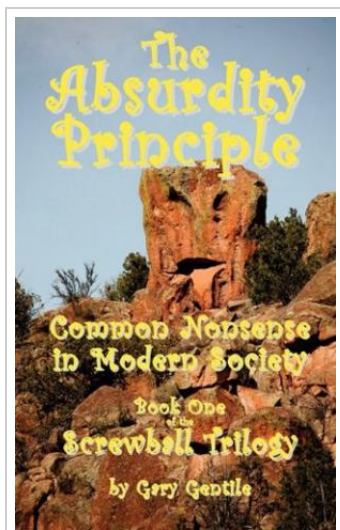




The Absurdity Principle (Paperback)
