This change is still continuing. Thereby until the 1960s only 24 per cent of all students were female. The positive trend is among other things supported by the Bologna Process. The increase of the last decades concerning women who study will proceed in future. There are several reasons to mention. The disproportionate part of women attending higher education - in 2003 55 per cent of the high-school graduates were female - represents the significant change. In some federal states like Brandenburg or Thuringia the share of women is even 60 per cent. Therefore the amount of young people who start studying has almost quadrupled since 1960. This great leap from 8, 5 per cent to 42, 5 per cent can not be stated with the same proportion among men. Their fraction only rose from 12, 5 per cent to 36, 5 per cent.
