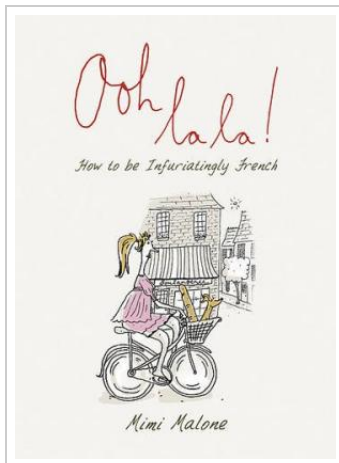




Ooh La La!: How to be Infuriatingly French (Hardback)
