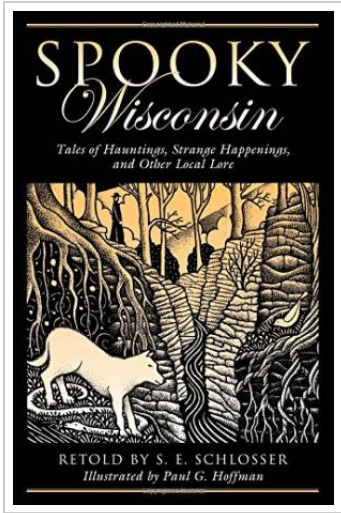




Spooky Wisconsin: Tales of Hauntings, Strange Happenings, and Other Local Lore (Paperback)
