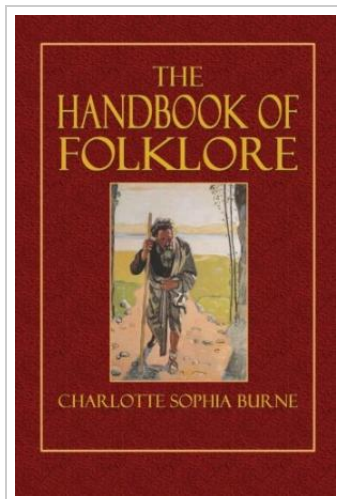




The Handbook of Folklore

Although the present handbook retains the name and the general scheme of classification of the original work, it has been so completely re-written and expanded that it has become, to all intents and purposes, an entirely new book. Its appearance, which, for several years, has been expected by students of its subject, has well fulfilled their anticipations, and Miss Burne is to be congratulated on its completion, for she undertook it simultaneously with, and in addition to, other important literary work connected with the Folk-Lore Society. Divided into three parts- Belief and Practice, Customs, and Stories and Savings -the book covers the whole of that learning of the people (whether they be or be not what we call civilised folk) which is termed, shortly, Folklore. The headings of the chapters show the fascinating nature of the field to be covered, and...
