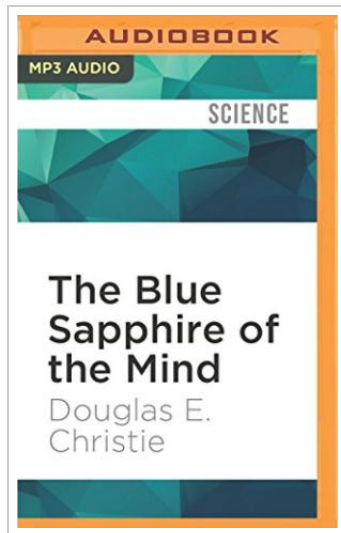




The Blue Sapphire of the Mind: Notes for a Contemplative Ecology
