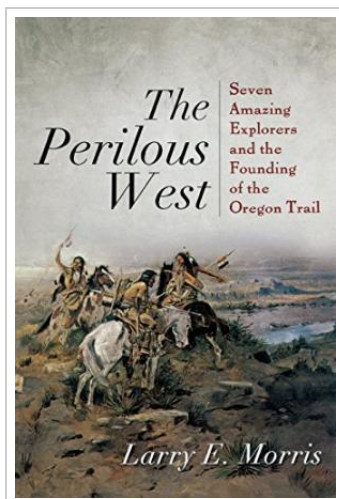




The Perilous West: Seven Amazing Explorers and the Founding of the Oregon Trail (Paperback)
