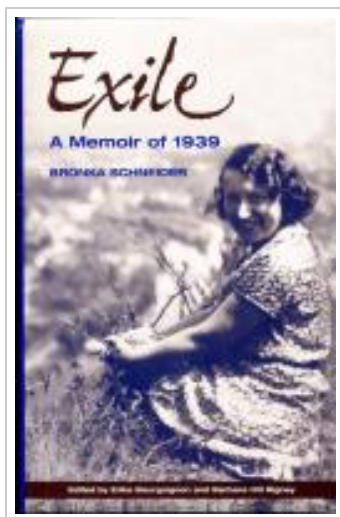




Exile: a memoir of 1939
