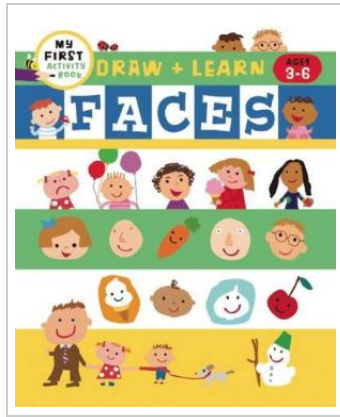




Draw + Learn: Faces (My First Activity Books)
