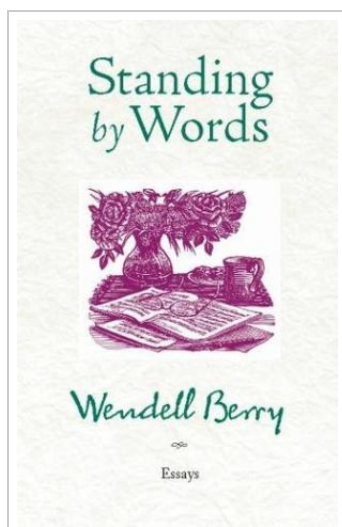




Standing by Words
