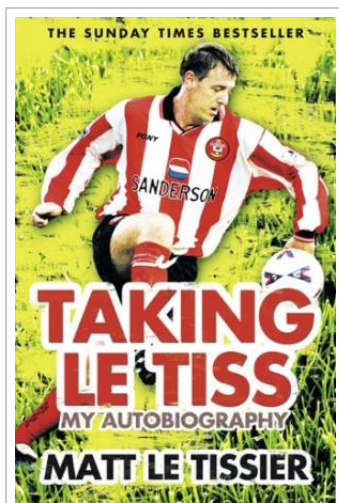




Taking Le Tiss
