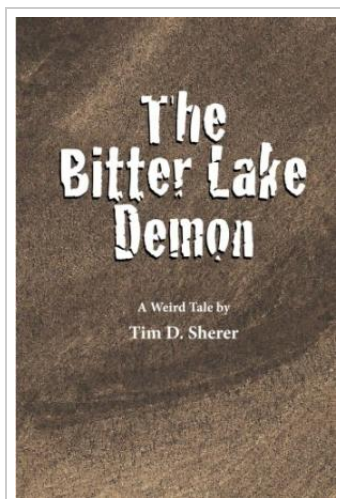




The Bitter Lake Demon
