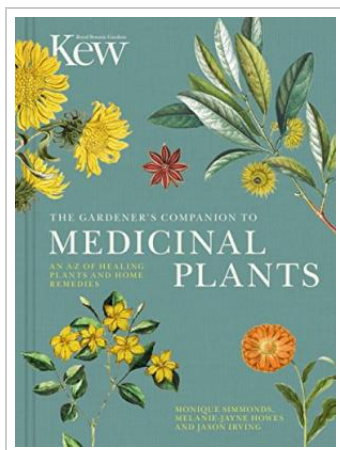




The Gardeners Companion to Medicinal Plants
