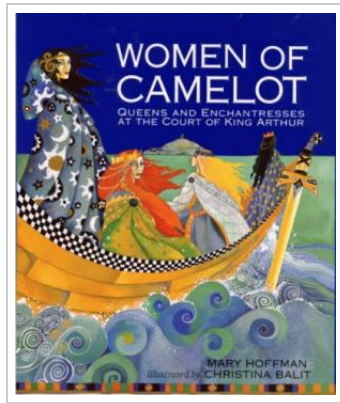




Women of Camelot: Queens and Enchantresses at the Court of King Arthur
