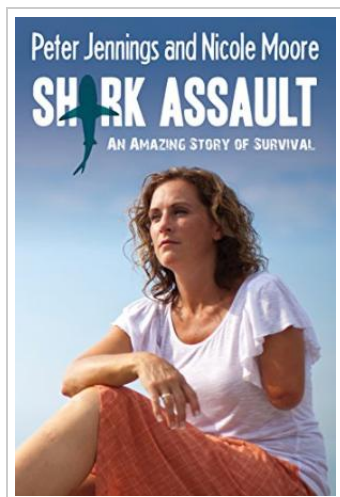




Shark Assault
