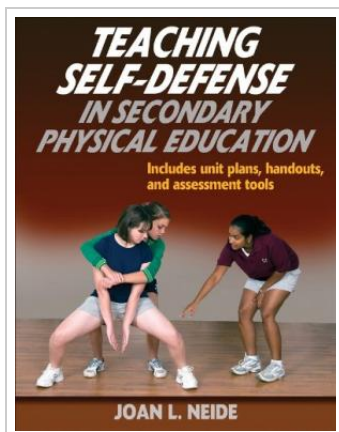




Teaching Self-defense in Secondary Physical Education
