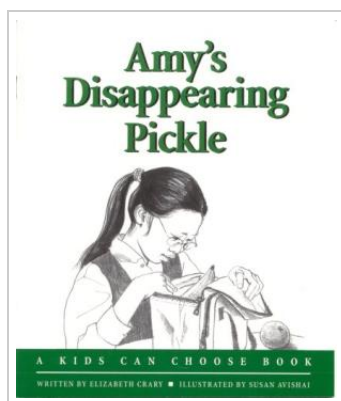



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Amy's Disappearing Pickle

The stories also give adults an opportunity to ask children what other solutions they can suggest. When something disappears out of your lunch box or your locker or your desk every day, you'd like to say, "No big deal". But even minor theft is a big deal to kids. Amy's Disappearing Pickle shows children several different ways of ending an annoying problem. Like all "Kids Can Choose" books, this story about theft emphasizes brainstorming solutions and evaluating each option before taking action.
