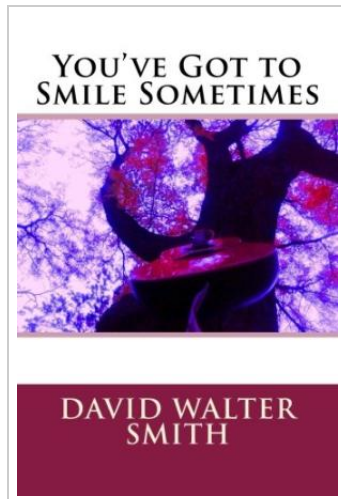




You ve Got to Smile Sometimes
