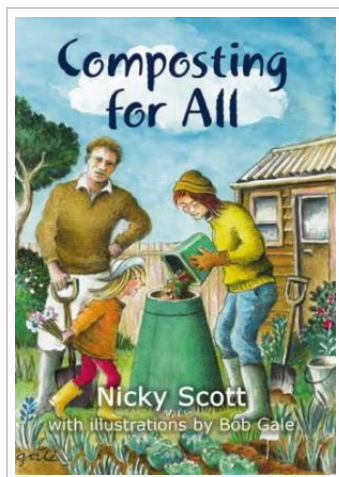




Composting for All
