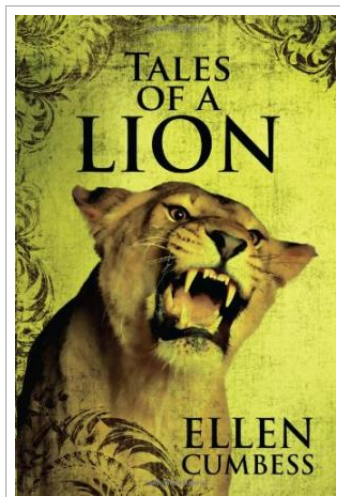




Tales of a Lion (Paperback)
