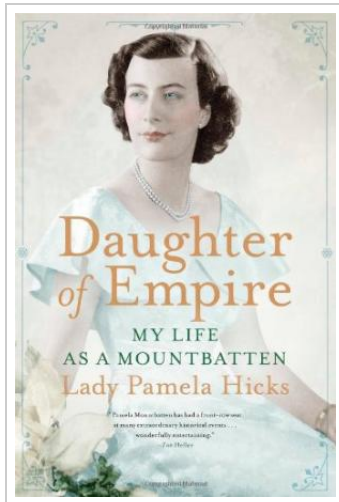




Daughter of Empire: My Life as a Mountbatten (Hardback)
