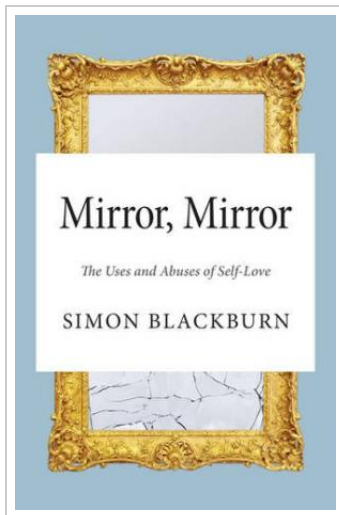




Mirror: The Uses and Abuses of Self-Love
