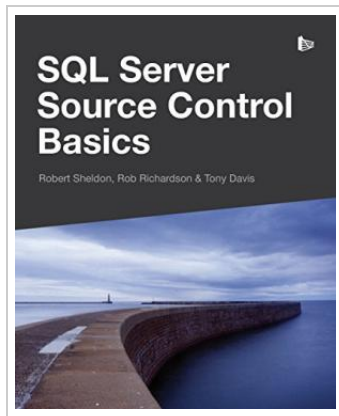


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SQL Server Source Control Basics

Yet without source control to maintain the scripts necessary to create our database objects, load lookup data, and take other actions, we cannot guarantee a reliable and repeatable database deployment process, let alone coordinate database upgrades with changes to the application. We also run the risk that our ad hoc database patching will cause inconsistencies and data loss.
