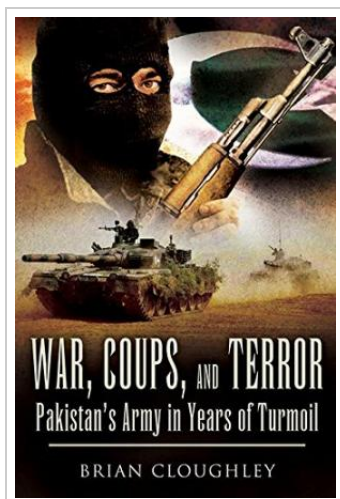




War, Coups Terror: Pakistan's Army in Years of Turmoil (Paperback)
