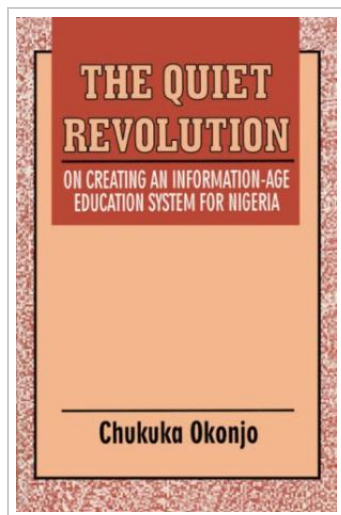




The Quiet Revolution: Education System for Nigeria
