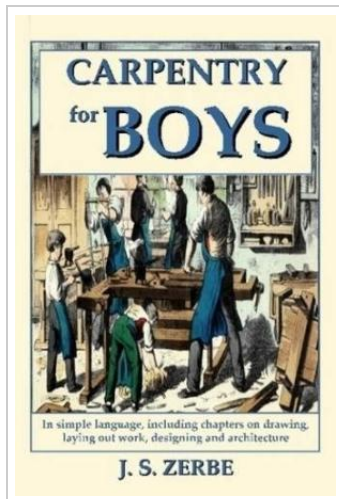




Carpentry for Boys (Paperback)
