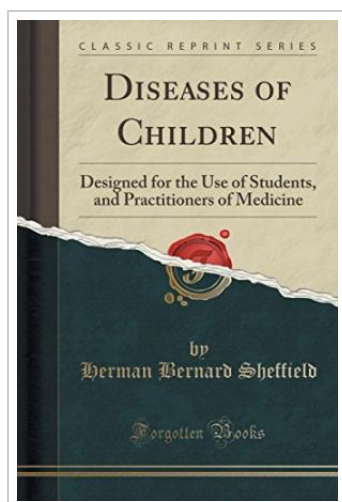

Breast feeding is recommended in preference to bottle feeding, yet the author believes that hosts of perfectly healthy babies can be reared on cow's milk, if good judgment is applied in the selection of suitable milk mixtures....



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
