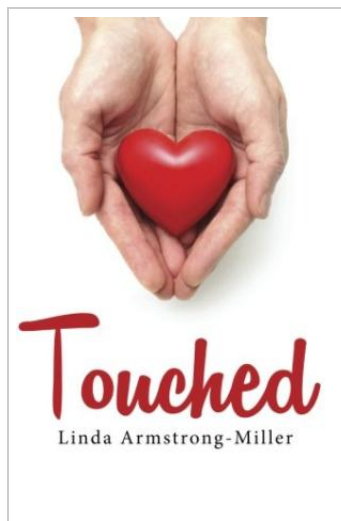




Touched
