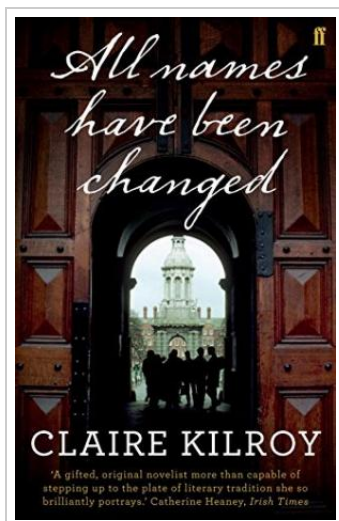




All Names Have Been Changed (Paperback)
