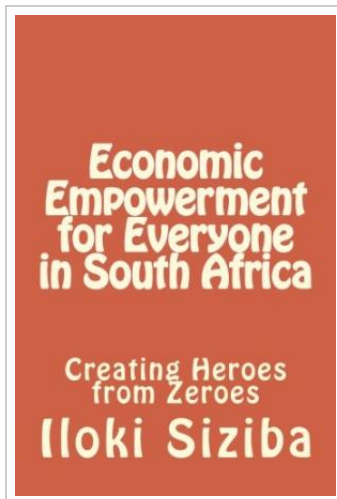




Economic Empowerment for Everyone in South Africa: Creating Heroes from Zeroes (Paperback)
