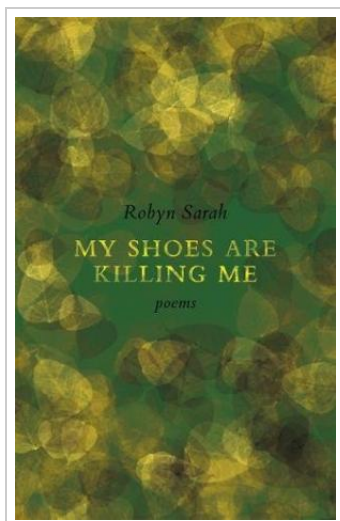




My Shoes Are Killing Me (Paperback)
