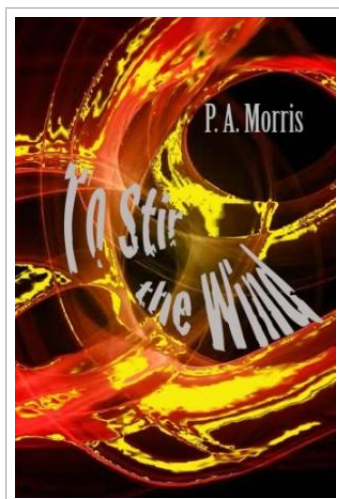




To Stir the Wind
