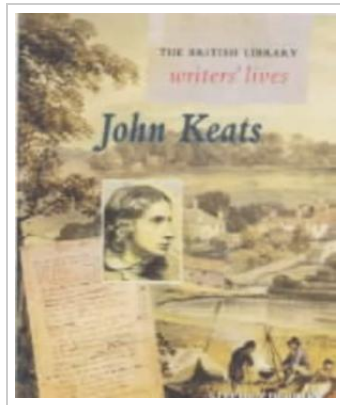




John Keats
