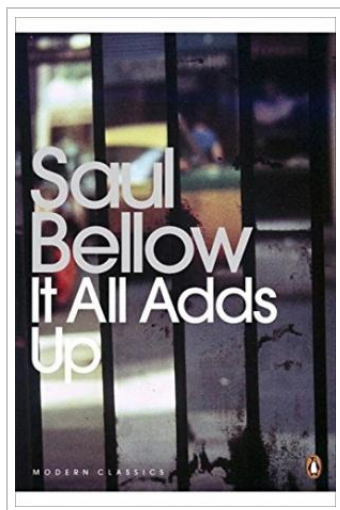




It All Adds Up
