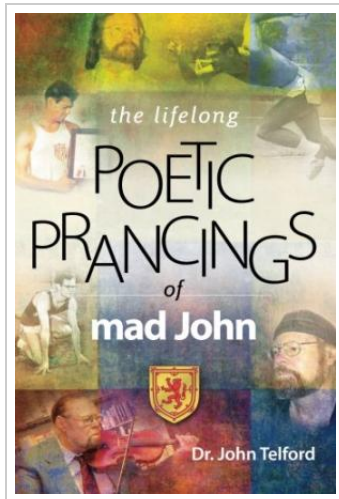




The Lifelong Poetic Prancings of Mad John (Paperback)
