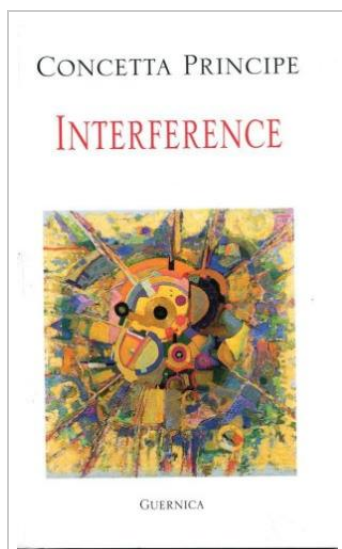




Interference (Paperback)
